

“Art for Advocacy” Poster Contest Official Rules (Grades 6–12)

Theme

In recognition of April’s **Strengthening Families Month**, students are encouraged to reflect on how **strong families, safe communities, and trusted adults** help children heal and thrive.

Who Can Participate

- Open to students in **grades 6–12**
- One poster per student

Poster Requirements

- Posters must include:
 - The **Two Rivers United Child Advocacy Center logo:**
 - **The words “Trust, Healing, Justice”**
- Posters must be created on **standard poster size** (recommended: 11 x 17 or 18 x 24)
- Artwork must be ORIGINAL and created using:
 - Hand-drawn or mixed media (markers, paint, colored pencils, collage)
 - No digital entries allowed
 - Posters should be appropriate for **school and public display**



Entry Information

- A completed **Participant Information Form** must be attached to the back of the poster
- Entries without contact information cannot be judged

Submission Instructions

- Entries must be received by **April 1st**
- Artwork may be submitted to:

Judging

Posters will be judged in the following grade groups:

- Middle School (Grades 6–8)
- High School (Grades 9–12)

Judging criteria include:

- Creativity and visual impact, incorporation of theme, effective use of the required words and logo

Awards

- Selected posters will be recognized during April’s “Strengthening Families Month”
 - **Winners announced at “Family Fun Fair” – April 15th 4-6 p.m. @ Lewiston City Library**
 - Middle School / High School Category winners will receive prize package valued at \$100
