**Official Rules (Grades K-5)**

**Theme**

In recognition of April's **Strengthening Families Month**, students are encouraged to reflect on how **strong families, safe communities, and trusted adults** help children heal and thrive.

**Eligibility**

- Open to children in **Kindergarten through 5th Grade** – 1 entry per/child

**Artwork Guidelines**

- Use the **official Art for Advocacy coloring page** provided and complete entry information on back
- Artwork must be **colored by the child only**
- Acceptable materials include **crayons, colored pencils, markers, watercolor**

**Entry Information**

- The **participant information page** must be completed and attached
- Entries without completed contact information cannot be judged

**Submission**

- Entries must be received by **April 1st**
- Artwork may be submitted to:

**Judging**

Artwork will be judged by age group: creativity, use of color, expression of the theme, effort and originality

- Kindergarten–1st Grade
- 2nd–3rd Grade
- 4th–5th Grade

- Winners will be selected from each age group and receive prize package valued at \$50
- Winners and prizes announced at the April Strengthening Families Month “Family Fun Fair”
